# Is YOUR Business compliant with First Aid Regulations?

80% of businesses in the UK are non compliant to first aid regulations...this catalogue and guide are here to help you make the decisions to make your business compliant in first aid equipment and supplies.

The Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981 require employers to provide 'adequate and appropriate equipment, facilities and personnel to ensure their employees receive immediate attention if they are injured or taken ill at work.'

These Regulations apply to all workplaces including those with less than five employees and to the self-employed.

What is 'adequate and appropriate' will depend on the circumstances in the workplace. This includes whether trained first-aiders are needed, what should be included in a first-aid box and if a first-aid room is required. Employers should carry out an assessment of first-aid needs to determine what to provide.

The Regulations do not place a legal duty on employers to make first-aid provision for non-employees such as the public or children in schools. However, HSE strongly recommends that non-employees are included in an assessment of first-aid needs and that provision is made for them.

### Assessment of first aid needs

Employers are required to carry out an assessment of first-aid needs. This involves consideration of workplace hazards and risks, the size of the organisation and other relevant factors, to determine what first-aid equipment, facilities and personnel should be provided.

This catalogue and guide are here to help you make those important decisions as part of assessing your business for the equipment and supplies required in this assessment.

All catalogue pages are divided in to low, medium and high risk categories, with suggested uses and constructive ideas that help make your risk assessment decisions easier to make.

### **Burns First Aid Kits**

Burns kits and dressings should form a fundamental part of any risk assessment you carry out, whether in a low risk environment like an office right through to high risk areas such as foundries and refineries.

In any circumstance hydrogel burn dressings are up to 400% more effective at cooling burns than water alone, gives rapid pain relief, decreases healing time and helps prevent scarring.

## **BurnFree Works!**

How? BurnFree gel draws the heat out of burn injuries and into the hydrogel. This cools the burn injury providing pain relief and helps stop the burn progression. BurnFree also keeps the wound site moist so that the body will not lose more water, helping to keep burn victims from entering into shock. BurnFree is a viscous gel. This allows the exposed nerve endings to be covered by the gel, offering near immediate pain relief.

While water will cool the burn, it is often difficult if not impossible to keep water over the entire burn area. Also, a large volume of water is required to cool even a small burn. BurnFree works best because the BurnFree gel is viscous, meaning that it will stay on the burn and draw out the heat, making it easier to cool the burn with BurnFree than with water. By covering the burn site, BurnFree will also help to prevent contamination until medical care is obtained.

Dressings — All BurnFree dressings are designed for first aid use on all types of burn injuries. The dressings are constructed of a special soft, open cell foam and are elastic enough to allow possible swelling or the need to flex joints. BurnFree dressings are non adherent and the inert foam will not shed threads, strands or fibres that could get embedded in the wound. The pliable foam holds 50 times its weight in gel meaning the gel will always stay in contact with the burn

Pain Relieving Gel – BurnFree gel is designed to be viscous enough to remain on the burn wound and not run off(like cheaper alternatives), whilst simultaneously drawing the heat out and up into the gel. Fire/Trauma blankets – BurnFree blankets are for emergency and industrial use. During transport to the medical facility the blanket will soothe the victim, reducing physiological and psychological trauma. The blankets are made of pure vigin wool which holds up to 14 times its weight in gel to prolong trauma relief during transport.

## Eyewash

All areas where there is a risk of eye injury must have suitable eye wash facilities. These take a number of forms, from fixed eye wash stations to single use sterile bottles and pods. When dealing with eye injuries ensure your stations are suitably placed for easy and speedy access.
