Part		Function
1	Heel Grip	 For re-positioning the Anti-Fatigue Standing Desk Mat
2	Teardrop Flex Center	 For massaging the arches of your foot
3	Raised Side Panels	For varying your stance
4	Textured Massage Bar	 For calf stretches, core balancing, or foot massages
